

Sunday Morning Adult Education: *If Jesus is not Lord of all, He is not Lord at all*

We understand that if the Gospel is true, which we believe it is, then it is simply true about everyone and for everyone. If Jesus is King of kings and Lord of lords, then he is the head of every aspect of creation.

If it is the truth for some and not for others, as some hold, then it isn't really the truth at all.

Thus if Jesus is not Lord of all, He is not Lord at all.

But we do indeed hold that Jesus is Lord of all...not just over the spiritual part of our lives, or a certain segment of the created order...but Jesus is the Lord of our lives, Lord of our families, Lord of our community, our nation and the world, and is finally Lord of all eternity and the author and the cause of our salvation.

Our Sunday morning class will explore all the aspects of this eternal and all encompassing truth. We will introduce this exploration with a basic understanding of how we look through the eyes of this faith, and then examine in order how this truth was revealed in the Old Testament, its implications as articulated in the New Testament; how the church has acted within this understanding throughout history, how we are to apply such a faith today, and what such a truth looks like in our daily lives.
